Y6 PGL Residential Trip: Friday 12th June 2026 – Monday 15th June 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to share the details of our residential trip for Y6 pupils. As mentioned in our Parent and Carer Information session, past pupils and parents have always spoken extremely positively about the residential trip, and how it had created a long lasting memory and end of year celebration of their time at Roxbourne.

PGL is a reputable company, and I have led eight successful residential trips to three of their centres. Established in 1957, PGL has been the UK's leading outdoor education provider, creating life enriching adventures for many school children over the years. There will be opportunities for children to try a range of activities, including:

- Zip Wire
- Climbing
- Raft Building
- Canoeing
- Abseiling
- Outdoor Heated Swimming Pool

These activities are designed to motivate, build confidence and encourage development, not to mention the wonderful time they will have bonding with each other.

The plan will be to spend 4 days at PGL Windmill Hill, which is located in East-Sussex, approximately 2 hours away.

Every year we negotiate a price with PGL that we feel offers value for money and we're pleased to say that we were able to secure the same price as last year which is a total of £296 (£148 if you're eligible for pupil premium). To secure your child's place on the trip, please make the first payment of **£59.20** to the school via Arbor by **Friday 24th October 2025**. Please refer to the table below for when future payments are due. You have the option to pay more than the termly amount stated in the table or pay the full amount of **£296**. Please note that if you are a recipient of pupil premium support, then the total amount due is **£148** with termly payments of **£29.60**.
